  - Has interactive questions, quizzes to check understanding
  - Goes from K-12 (so you can focus on different students at different levels)
  - Can pause and bring up discussion questions in the middle of lesson
  - Ability to create your own rhyme and beat.
- *3.* Legislative Platform- *Beth Sweeney* (Coordinator for Government Relations for our School District)
  - Sessions started last Tuesday (01.9.18) and run for 60 days
  - Platform is divided into 3 areas State Funding, State Policy, and Federal
  - Gave us handout on what would be discussed during sessions.
  - Biggest things were restoring the local capital outlay millage authority to 2 mills and to maintain the Required Local Effort Rate
  - Ways we can get involved (a) build an effective message when contacting your legislator, (b) have a solution to fix your issue, (c) select a priority issue, (d) make it
