1. Call to order- *Leslie Cabo/Jennifer Nunes*
 - a. Approve Agenda – Motion made by A. Shea and C. Woolston
 - b. Approve minutes from the March 21, 2017 meeting – Motion made by K. Butler and V. Reigert-Johnson
2. Technology Update- Chris Debus, PVPV Rawlings Technology Support Specialist
 - a. This summer there will be upgrades to the network cables – this will allow for the capability of more devices being run on the system
 - b. Phasing out N-Computing (1 desktop with multiple screens) at the PVPV Campus –it's an obsolete system (motherboard and memory are over 12 years old) – system cannot handle multiple tasks and cannot be used for testing
 - Tiered Replacement Plan starting with Kindergarten
 - 5 computers per classroom, 90 total computers
 - Kindergarten – 3 classrooms/15 computers; 1st – 7 classrooms/35 computers; 2nd – 8 classrooms/40 computers
 - Will be refurbishing older laptops (HP65306, Lenovo T420i) -will have sound and new capabilities –will allow for individual workstations
 - Media Centers will still continue to use N-Computing (for AR, IXL, Research) – testing/Star will be done on new computers in back.
 - c. Interactive Boards
 - Replacing Smartboards (\$1600/board) with less expensive option, Mimeo Teach (1/2 cost)
 - Wireless and uses existing wipe boards which allows for more space
 - Increases space of viewing size
 - d. Actiontec Wireless Projection Devices (WiDi)
 - Allows laptops to work connection free
 - Teachers can roam classroom without having to be stationary and connected to cables

- Sound is projected through the WiDi and connected sound system
- e. With combo if Mimeo and WiDi, campus will be essentially wireless

- a. We will be voting on funds for the 2016-2017 school year at the next meeting

4. Needs Assessment Survey – Leslie Cabo

- a. Update of survey totals – almost **doubled** feedback from last year
 - 139 Parents Responses, 97 Teacher Responses
 - District generated questions, we cannot change them, but we can add to them.

5. Principal Updates – *Caty Van Housen*

- a. Saturday, April 22nd – Dad's club will be working on the school grounds
- b. Getting to the end of the year! Teachers are busy planning celebrations, working on summer learning opportunities, creating the planner for next year, general preparations for the upcoming year.
- c. Tomorrow, April 20th will be budget meeting with the district. Confident we have our ducks in a row!
- d. Projection for next year is 1021 Students
 - 5th grade class going out is 198 students, no other grade that big
 - "Lottery" of kids ended up no having a huge effect, so room to grow

6. Funds Request

- a. J. Nunes – Professional Development on May 11th
 - PD for ALL teachers on iReady program
 - Helps with reading and math proficiency – gains for all students
 - Need 10 substitutes to rotate through the grades to cover teachers while in training
 - \$100 per substitute, \$1000 total needed
 - Motion made by K. Butler and E. Davis to approve, all committee members approved
- b. K. Scribner – Florida Art Education Mini Conference
 - Provides knowledge, skills, and support that will allow for highest quality of instruction possible to students
 - Needs \$125 to cover cost of registration
 - Motion made by E. Davis and J. Cox, all committee members approved
