3. FortifyFL App – *Kyle Dresback, Associate Superintendent for Student Support Services*
 - a. App allows you to enter information about what is happening around you or with another student/staff member
 - b. Enter School/County, tips and details, photo or video options. Optional to enter Name/email/phone number, and you can always add to your tip later
 - c. School/Sheriff/District & FDoE/Local Law Enforcement receive tips
 - d. Tips have come in via email/text/phone
 - e. Out of the 14 tips SJCS have received, mostly have been code of conduct tips and 2 were considered nonsense tips
 - f. Responders follow policy/procedures before the tip is closed
 - g. Link is live on all school/district home pages
 - h. 6,922 active schools and 222 law enforcement offices across the state are actively using the app – so far 167 tips have been reported state wide
 - i. Do not have to have the app to use, can call or go to the website: www.getfortifyfl.com
 - j. Trying to create a culture of “see something, say something”

4. 2018-2019 Mathematics Adoption – *Lisa Brubaker*
 - a. PVPV Rawlings has had Go Math for past 5 years
 - b. District has decided to look for a new publisher – 4 contenders
 - i. Curriculum Associates
 - ii. Houghton Mifflin Harcourt
 - iii. ORIGO Education

- iv. Pearson
 - c. Encouraged to get feedback from Parents and Teachers
 - d. Committee (1 teacher from each grade level/ESE) has been formed at the school to discuss and rate the materials
 - e. Committee members take info back to their teams, which then pick their top 2
 - f. List is compiled of everyone's top 2, then the school will pick the top 2 from they recommend
 - g. December 5th is the Publisher presentation
 - h. January – open public hearing and receive public comment
 - i. February - SJCSD will take a vote, they have a 30-day waiting period
 - j. April – final answer
 - k. District wide adoption (k-12) - Schools will plan to start with the new program 2019 Fall semester
