Get it?

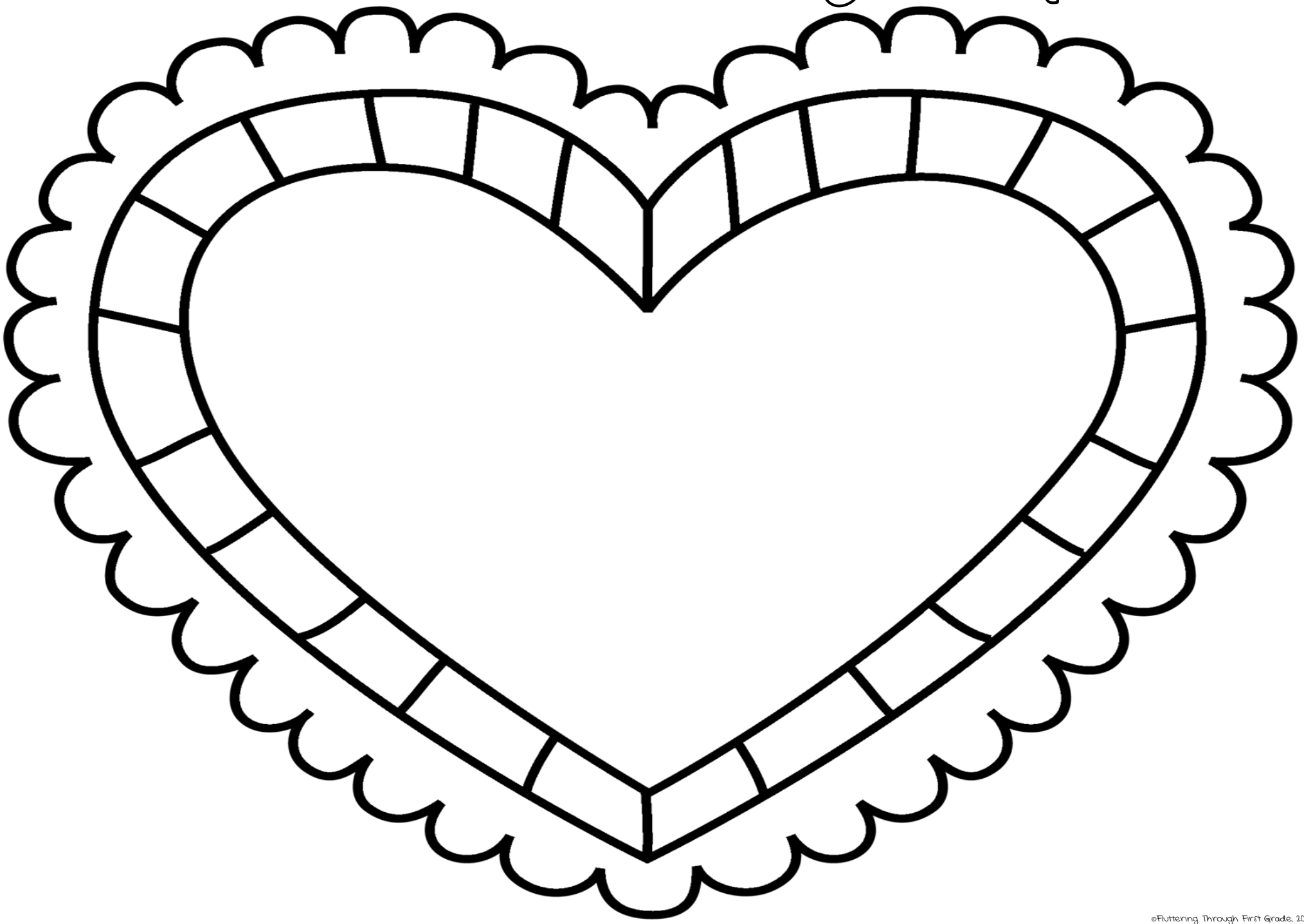
Compliments written on a 12x18 piece of construction paper, about the size of a place mat.

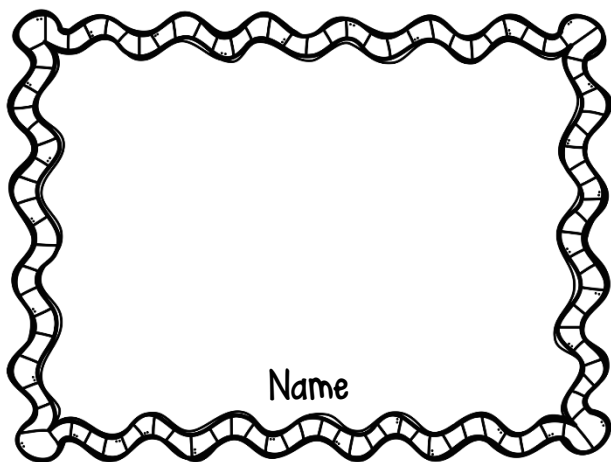
