- 4. Guest ~ Stephanie Hammett district assessment coordinator (state testing)
 - a. K-2 completed PM1 by deadline
 - i. A few technical difficulties/Average of 20 minutes spent on testing
 - *ii.* Renaissance scores use a percentile rank of 40, however a PR of 50 was used on FSA and is more aligned with a level 3. So, scores may appear slightly inflated.
 - *iii.* Hard copies of reports provided to parents for PM1. Reports will be shared though an online family portal available for PM2/PM3.
 - b. Grades 3-10 completed PM 1 by deadline
 - *i.* Test took longer than expected. Recommended testing times from the state are not adequate. The state is aware of timing issue but no changes yet.
 - *ii.* This year is a baseline year, based on FSA score levels. State will create new cut scores based on this year's data. Only PM3 will be used for accountability
 - *iii.* 4-10 graders will have writing field test (April 3-21, 2023). Computer-based. Writing scores will be reported separately and won't contribute to students' ELA

scores. Only some schools will participate in the writing field test. Schools should know by October 2022.
