*What will the district do?:* Plans to close St. Johns Tech High, cut district level positions, increase class size (20 in K-3, 22 in 4-5), removing relocatables, closing some district offices spaces and moving those people into open spaces in schools, increasing enrollment at St. Johns Virtual, consolidating summer school locations, reviewing support personnel allocations, sharing positions.
