SCHOOL HOURS & SCHEDULE

Our school day is from 8:30 am to 2:50 pm. Wednesday is early release at 1:50 pm. The first bell rings at 8:20 am. Students may enter the school beginning at 8:10 and wait for their teachers outside their classrooms until 8:20. The tardy bell rings at 8:30, and this is when all students are expected to be in their classrooms. Morning announcements begin promptly at 8:25. Students are marked late if they enter after 8:30.

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP PROCEDURES

It is very important that parents follow our carpool line rules because our school is located on A1A. The majority of our students ride the bus and we encourage you to send your student on the bus if it this service is available to you. The bus designates the first two rows for kindergarten students. If you prefer to drive your child, please, no cell phones while in carline. Have your child ready to exit when the car door is opened. Our safety patrol, staff, and PTO will be at school the first week to assist your child with getting to their classroom. Thank you for your support!

Children may bring or buy their lunch. Lunch is \$2.70 for a full meal. Milk may be purchased a la carte for \$.60. You may send money in an envelope or set up an account through PAYPAMS. You will receive a menu each month and two entrees are available most days.

VISITING & VOLUNTEERING IN THE CLASSROOM

All visitors must check in at the office and wear a visitor's badge to keep our school safe. Anyone coming on campus to volunteer must be cleared with the district to do so. **Visit the school's website to register to become a cleared volunteer!** Visitors and volunteers are welcome in our classroom. Thank you for considering sharing your time with us! We think you will find it an informative and enjoyable way to learn about your child's school experience and help children in the class.

We begin regularly scheduled volunteer times **after the school's scheduled Open House.** This block of time allows your child to become an independent worker in the classroom before you begin volunteering. It also allows the teacher to devote his/her full attention to getting to know the children and begin the yearlong learning process.

You may also come and eat lunch with your child in the cafeteria Monday-Thursday during their scheduled lunch time. Clearance is required for this as well.
