**We will be conducting the handout over two days.** Students at PVPV will receive their bags on Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup>. Students at Rawlings will be scheduled for Tuesday March 31<sup>st</sup>. **If you have multiple children at both schools, you do NOT need to come both days.** We have a plan for that.

No matter what day you are coming, please have your car rider tag in the window, or a handwritten sign with your child's name and homeroom to help us gather the needed materials. Please stay in your car, we will load through the window or the door!

Here's how to proceed. Pick your category.

**I have one child at PVPV Rawlings in grades K-2.**

Easy. Print out the PVPV schedule and come during your time slot on Monday.

**I have one child at Rawlings in grades 3-5.**

Easy. Print out the Rawlings schedule and come during your slot on Tuesday.

**I have multiple children, all on the same campus, what do I do?**

Still easy. Just come during one of your homeroom slots. You can pick which one. Let us know the names and homerooms of all your children. We will gather both bags and deliver. Might just take a little bit longer for us to get the bag from the other grade level.

**I have multiple children, and they are on both campuses? How can you make this work?**

Just a little more complicated, but we have you covered. You can choose which day to come. If you come Monday with your PVPV child, come during their homeroom slot. We will load at the PVPV bus loop first. We will then walkie to the Rawlings campus so that those materials will be waiting for you when you drive through the Rawlings pick up line to pick up your 3-5 grade student materials.

If you come Tuesday, come during to your Rawlings homeroom slot, and go through Rawlings car line first. We will walkie to the PVPV building and have your materials ready as you drive through the bus loop.

**I can't make it during my homeroom times.**

No problem. We will have a late pick-up from 4-5 on Tuesday at the Rawlings car line.

**Can I have a friend pick up materials.**

We know these are tough times and we are all trying to help each other out. Just have the names of the students and homerooms, and we will make it work. Just come during one of your slots!
