Dear St. Johns County Parents and Teachers,

Welcome back to school! I am thrilled to share that for the first time over, we will have a Deputy Sheriff in each St. Johns County public school within our jurisdiction. The St. Augustine Police Department has also partnered with the School District and has placed police officers at RB Hunt Elementary, Ketterlinus Elementary, and St. Joseph Academy. The partnership between our agency, the school district, and most importantly the families and students is vital to our success as a county.

As your Sheriff, I challenge all parents to continue being an active participant in your child's life. Their futures depend on it. As a youth coach in St. Johns County for nearly 30 years, I've seen first-hand the importance of strong mentorship and involvement with our youth.

I also challenge both parents and students to get to know your respective school's Youth Resource Deputy. The St. Johns County Sheriff's Office Youth Resource Deputies are there for each of you. If you hear or see something you think isn't right or you have a question about, reach out to them. It is paramount that our students know that the deputy in a uniform is a friend and there to be a resource to them.

In addition, our Youth Resource Deputies facilitate several in school programs, to include Safety Programs, Mentoring, Anti-Bullying Initiatives, Drug Prevention, and Intervention Programs. Our deputies provide guidance for the safe use of the internet and computers. Technology is a great tool to assist in education but it can also bring its own challenges for parents and children. It is incredibly important for parents to remain vigilant and aware of what their children's activities online and otherwise are. Together, we can restrict those who attempt to exploit our children.

We will continue to encourage you and your child to utilize the FortifyFL app when suspicious information is learned by our schools and students. These tips are relayed to law enforcement and school officials for immediate investigation.

Lastly, I'd like to thank you for your continued support of law enforcement in St. Johns County. It is truly our honor to be of service to you. 



PVPV/Rawlings Rocks! "Rent the Rock"



The Spirit Rock is a great way to send a message for all to see! For a reservation of \$35/day, congratulate your favorite student, wish them happy birthday (or "half" birthday), show appreciation to your favorite teacher or staff member, or just let everyone know how much you love PVPV/Rawlings Elementary School!

RESERVATIONS

Reservations are made online via the Sign Up Genius link, located on the school website. All reservation dates are listed; slots will not be modified. Reservations are processed on a first-come, first-serve basis. Keep in mind that the earlier you make your reservation, the more likely you are to get your desired date. There are only 180 school days, and we have over 1000 students, so please be understanding if you don't get your desired date. Any family may rent the rock up to (3) days per semester. These days may be in a row or separate days throughout the semester. The renting of the rock runs on the honor system; we hope everyone respects the guidelines set by the school administration.

HOW TO PAINT THE ROCK

All artwork painted on the rock must be in good taste and may not contain any foul or derogatory language, religious, political, or offensive statement/symbols. The messages or designs must be positive! School administration has the right to paint over and revoke further painting privileges for individuals who do not abide by these rules.

Families need to provide their own paint and supplies. Spray paint may be used to cover the previous message. Use only "standard" latex or water-based paint on the rock. Painting of school property, besides the rock, is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, sidewalks, asphalt, lamp posts, or buildings. Any damage to the surrounding area or building will result in financial responsibility for repairs to the responsible party.

There are no trash cans or water supply available. Please bring appropriate bags to clean up afterwards. Paint cans are not allowed to be put in dumpsters on school property.

WHEN CAN I PAINT THE ROCK?

Painting of the rock may occur anytime between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. on the day before your rental. For instance, if you are renting the rock on Tuesday, August 24, you may paint the rock anytime between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. on Monday, August 23. If you are renting the rock on Monday, you will need to paint the rock the Friday before between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m.

WHAT IF IT'S RAINING WHEN IT'S TIME FOR ME TO PAINT?

In the event of inclement weather, please plan on painting with an umbrella in hand. For severe weather that prohibits afternoon painting, you may paint from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. on the day you rent the rock. The PTO will not give refunds on rock reservations. If you are unable to paint on the rock on your scheduled date, please try to trade with another family. PLEASE MARK YOUR CALENDARS!!!

On paypams.com, you will be able to see your child's purchases and how much money they have left on their account. Pleases keep your students account current. Your child may get breakfast everyday and it will include a breakfast entrée, fruit, juice and milk. If your child gets a second entrée, then he or she will be charged as ala carte. We also have one cool box, daily, for lunch that includes yogurt, graham crackers, sliced apples, carrot dippers with ranch, and a choice of another vegetable and milk.





FLORIDA LAW ON VEHICLE CHILD RESTRAINT

All children aged 5 and younger must be restrained in a federally approved, crash tested, child restraint device. This includes separate carriers, boosters, or vehicle manufacturer integrated child seat.
