What does SAC do?

- assists the principal with the annual budget
- assists in the preparation and evaluation of the School Improvement Plan (SIP)
- approves the expenditure of school funds
- supports school improvement implementation
- collects and analyzes information about the community and the school and receives public input regarding the needs (Needs Assessment) of the school.
- reviews school-wide data, identifies areas for growth, and discusses ways to improve
- · Adheres to the "Sunshine Law"
- SAC & the school's staff jointly decide on how to spend A+ recognition money.
- attends all SAC meetings




Our sea turtles are doing a great job of working hard, being kind, and being awesome! Thank you to SurfSide for sponsoring our positive behavior program!
