Guidelines:

- All students must always be accompanied by an adult during their performance.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for making sure the content of the performance is school appropriate.
- Parents/guardians must assist their child while using the equipment (i.e. turning mic volume up/down, plugging a guitar into the amp. etc). A music teacher will be on site checking on each performance area but may not be at your specific area when you are performing.
- Time slots will be available online through Sign Up Genius. Slots are 15 minutes a piece. Students may also perform in small groups. Only one student per group needs to sign up.
- There will be three performance areas available. Please make sure you sign up for the area that has the equipment you will need to perform. All stations are available for all grade levels.
- The Signup Genius will close at midnight on April 2, 2025.

Area One: Rawlings Main Entrance (by the office)

Equipment provided: Piano and a music stand. This area is designated for any type instrumentalist (piano/woodwind/string/percussion). In addition, it is designated for students who would like to play the piano while they sing. Lastly, it is for any instrumentalists/vocalists who are bringing someone to accompany them on the piano. Please note that there is not a microphone in this area.

<u>Area Two: Rawlings Parent Pickup/Dropoff Entrance (by Ms. Hollis' Room)</u>

Equipment provided: Bose speaker with an aux cord, a microphone, and a music stand. You can sing and play an accompaniment track simultaneously with this speaker. The device playing the accompaniment track would need to plug into a headphone jack. If you need to test your ability to plug in from your device, contact Kyra.Livingston@stjohns.k12.fl.us. This area is designated for singers who need a microphone/have an accompaniment track.

Area Three: PVPV Main Entrance (by the office)

Equipment provided: Piano, guitar amplifier, and a music stand. The amplifier has the capability to plug in your personal microphone and sing a cappella. This area is designated for singers with no accompaniment and string players with a pickup.
