We're setting up three performance areas: two at Rawlings and one at PVPV. If you'd like to perform, please sign up no later than **April 2**, **2025**.



FortifyFL automatically routes your tip report to the appropriate law enforcement agencies and school officials.



Your School Officials The tip report goes to your local school officials when submitted.

Your local police department or sheriff office receive copies of your tips automatically.

State-Level Officials

State-level officials also have access to your tips to make sure proper steps are taken.

FortHyFL is a suspicious activity reporting tool that allows you to instantly relay information to appropriate law enforcement agencies and school officials. FortHyFL was created and funded by the 2018 Fiorida Legislature as part of the Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School Public Safety Act.

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
