Do you like to sing? Do you play an instrument? Do you enjoy performing for others?


If so, consider signing up to share your musical talent as one of our **street performers** at the school's **Night of the Arts on April 9**th!

We're setting up three performance areas: two at Rawlings and one at PVPV. If you'd like to perform, please sign up no later than **April 2**, **2025**.




Aspecial thank you to our amazing art teachers, Kristen Armstrong and Kim Scribner for planning this wonderful event for our sea turtles!




