



# HOW DO I APPLY?

COMPLETE ALL PARTS OF THE  
APPLICATION

AND TURN IT IN ON TIME.



1. Parent Permission Form
2. Application cover sheet with parent/applicant signature
3. Application paragraph
4. Classroom teacher recommendation
5. Resource teacher recommendation
6. If you are in ACE you must have an ACE recommendation

## page 1 – Cover Letter

- Tells you what you need to do.
- Dates due.
- How to contact me if you have questions.

### Safety Patrol Application Information



- To be a Safety Patrol you must be able to be at your assigned morning post no later than 8:00 a.m. and you must be able to stay at your assigned afternoon post until at least 3:05 p.m. **YOU MAY NOT RIDE THE BUS DURING YOUR TIME OF DUTY.** If you are unable to meet this requirement, please do not complete an application as you will not be able to be on the Team.
- If you do meet this requirement and would like to apply, please visit the PVPV Rawlings website at [www-pvmkr@stjohns.k12.fl.us](http://www-pvmkr@stjohns.k12.fl.us), print the entire application (see below). Complete and turn in the entire application **ON TIME** either via email to Mrs. Jason or at the Rawlings front office. **Late submissions will not be considered.**
- The application has 3 parts that are required by every applicant. If you attend ACE, your application will have 4 required parts. To be considered for a Safety Patrol position, ALL required parts must be completed and turned in **on time**.
  - **Part one:** The Parent Permission Form, the first page of the application and the application paragraph is completed by you and turned in to Ms. Jason by **April 8, 2026**. There will be a box on the counter in the front office to turn in your application or you may email it to Mrs. Jason
  - **Part two:** You must give your homeroom teacher the Homeroom teacher recommendation form. They will complete it and turn it in directly to Mrs. Jason by **April 8, 2026**.
  - **Part three:** You must ask a Resource teacher (of your choice) to complete a recommendation. You will give them the Resource teacher recommendation form. They will turn the recommendation form in directly to Ms. Jason by **April 8, 2026**.
  - **Part four:** **If you attend ACE**, you must provide an ACE teacher with the ACE recommendation form. They will complete and turn in directly to Ms. Jason by **April 8, 2026**.
- A team made up of teachers and administrators will review all applications. If you are selected to be a 2026-2027 Safety Patrol, you will be notified by the end of the day on April 24, 2026. ## FAQ's:

**How many Safety Patrol teams are there?** There are two teams – A team and B team.

**How do I get placed on a team?** The teams are built by equally dividing students.

**Can I request to be on a team with my friend or carpool buddy?** We cannot accommodate any requests to place students on the same team as their friends, neighbors or carpool buddies.


**How often will I be on duty?** For most of the school year, the teams will alternate TWO WEEKS on duty and then TWO WEEK off duty. For example, the first two weeks of school A Team will be ON duty and B Team will be OFF duty. The following two weeks of school, B Team is on duty and A Team is OFF duty. If a school holiday or day off occurs during your week of duty, you are just off that day. The days are not made up. There are a few times throughout the year that we might switch the schedule to ONE week ON DUTY and ONE week OFF DUTY. If/when a schedule change must occur, you will be made aware of the change.

**How will duty schedules be distributed?** We have monthly meetings and you will be given your new schedule at each meeting. A copy of the schedule is emailed to your parents. A copy of the schedule will always be posted on the Safety Patrol bulletin board.

# WHAT WOULD KEEP ME FROM BECOMING A SAFETY PATROL?

1. Application not turned in on time or incomplete
2. Unable to be at your post in the morning at 8:00 a.m. and stay at afternoon post until 3:05 p.m.
3. Number of applicants – not everyone will be able to be selected!


